As we rise from the ashes of a global pandemic, continue to see the atrocities of war against Ukraine and witness the depths of suffering which remain, deep in all our communities here and around the World.

I am humbled by the support from our continued partnerships with other organisations and the strength and commitment to support the most vulnerable families here in Salford. We have all got a lot busier as the lockdowns have lifted but we want to give special thanks to our friends at Salford Food Bank and The Castle Community Centre, Eccles who continue to support us so closely. You are amazing and our heartfelt thanks continues.

Our volunteers continue to strive to bring dignity to those who feel they have lost all hope. The brief visits, words of kindness and compassion accompany the beautiful packages they craft daily which continue to be delivered with specific family needs in mind. We are committed to help alleviate often desperate suffering and hardship. Our wonderful volunteers continue to ensure as far as possible all babies have enough milk and a safe place to sleep and rest their heads.

This year we have had the privilege to join the response to the needs of Afghan and Ukrainian refugees who have fled homes. We have supported refugees when they arrive with essential practical items in their new safe place to dwell as well as those who already call this amazing city of Salford home.

In total we have provided 1,678 packages to 469 families of which 81 were homeless families in temporary accommodation. With no paid members of staff, our Board of Trustees are tremendously proud and thankful for the dedication of our amazing team.



We are committed to continue to provide for the sons and daughters of Salford as we enter our third year at Salford Baby Bank. We believe this is a new season and as we transition, we hope to bring further support and care for those in our community who call Salford home and find themselves in crisis. Thank you for all the continued support and good will we continue to feel as we establish ourselves more permanently at St Luke's Church here in Langworthy & Weaste.

PREVENTION OF HARM



Daughters of Salford are determined to work together with those who are committed to work in partnership to address the health inequalities for women and families within our city. We know that the prevention of harm is vital and the need to meet families with practical resources is growing as the pandemic exacerbates the health divide.

Salford Baby Bank looks at referrals with prevention in mind. Our team is clinician led and attentive to the adverse childhood experiences which can impact health and well being in later life. The first 1001 days in a child's life are crucial and we aim to approach all referrals with eyes of prevention. All our care package provisions are practical and meet families needs in crisis and help to restore some dignity. Our safety care packages ensure all babies can sleep safe wherever they lay to sleep within our city.

UPDATES AWARENESS



WE CONTINUE TO DEVELOP THE PROJECT OF SALFORD BABY BANK IN COLLABORATION WITH SHARED HEALTH IN OLDHAM. THE HEALTHY GEM HUB HAS BEEN BORN OUT OF SALFORD BUT IS DEVELOPING A CLINICAL MODEL EMBEDDED IN PUBLIC HEALTH AND COMMITTED TO PROVIDING INDIVIDUALISED CARE FOR THOSE WOMEN AND CHILDREN MOST AFFECTED BY TRAUMA IN OUR COMMUNITIES. THIS IS SUPPORTED BY CLINICIANS AND PROFESSIONALS WHO ARE DESPERATE FOR CHILDREN TO THRIVE AND COMMITTED TO ENSURING HEALTH OUTCOMES ARE NOT FURTHER IMPACTED BY POVERTY.

WORKING ALONGSIDE LOCAL AUTHORITY HOUSING TEAMS WE HAVE SEEN THE NEED FOR PROVISIONS STAY MUCH THE SAME THIS YEAR AS FAMILIES WHO ARE HOMELESS AND IN TEMPORARY ACCOMMODATION SOAR. THE PROJECTS HAVE DOVETAILED AND REALLY REACH THOSE IN DESPERATE HARDSHIP.

WORKING WITH SHARED HEALTH FOR MY DAY JOB HAS BEEN A HUGE PRIVILEGE AS THE WORK TO LAUNCH THE ALL PARLIAMENTARY PARTY GROUP FOR HOMELESS FAMILIES IN TEMPORARY ACCOMMODATION. OUR TEAM SPOKE TO MP'S IN WESTMINSTER TO RAISE AWARENESS OF THE LIVES EXPERIENCES OF PREGNANT MUMS, EARLY YEARS AND ALL FAMILIES LIVING IN TEMPORARY ACCOMMODATION.

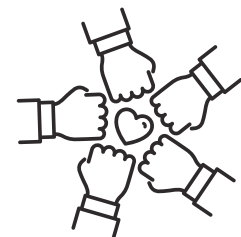
